

# Investing for Success

**Under this agreement for 2017  
Bundamba State School will receive**

**\$356,571**

## This funding will be used to

- A. Increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 3 reaching a “C” standard in English and Reading by 10%. Improve Year 3 and 5 Spelling results by 10% in the Upper 2 Bands.
- B. Increase the number of students reaching NMS (NAPLAN) in Reading across Year 3 and 5 by 10% each year. Target 100% of students above NMS.
- C. Increase the number of students reaching NMS (NAPLAN) in Numeracy across Year 3 and 5 by 10% each year. Target 100% of students above NMS.
- D. Develop and support a Whole school approach to differentiation and “data literacy” so that it is embedded as a shared approach to teaching and learning.

## Our initiatives include

- A. Maintaining a Home Reading program for Prep to Year 3. Embed cognitive conditioning in Spelling across the whole school. Provide focused and intensive support to students using LLI program.
- B. Through the development of the Whole School Curriculum Plan, providing coaching and professional development enhancing and deepening teacher capacity that underpins the Australian Curriculum.
- C. Deepening teachers’ capacity to design and deliver high quality teaching and assessment through the Mathematics Framework.
- D. Providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support based on case management processes.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

A. Provide support for the Home Reading. Students “at risk” targeted through the LLI program. HOC and SL&N to cognitive conditioning program.	\$90,000
B. Provide staff with a range of supports with a particular focus on Instructional Coaching in the key areas of Reading and Numeracy.	\$100,000
C. Engage the services of a Numeracy Co-ordinator and develop an intensive intervention program.	\$79,000
D. Maintain a cycle of identification and support for students. Supporting teachers in the development of SMART goals and ICPs.	\$87,571
